Project 1: Quality Indicators for Transition from Paediatric to Adult Care


Study objective: To establish a set of consensus-derived quality indicators to improve transition to adult care that are applicable across chronic health conditions, clinical care settings, and health jurisdictions.

Key activities to date:

• July 27, 2023, marked our inaugural iKT meeting. We are excited to have a group of diverse knowledge users working alongside our research team to reflect the needs and priorities of those receiving care and delivering transition care services.

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Project 2: Scoping review on patient, caregiver and knowledge user engagement in consensus-building healthcare initiatives

Comprehensive Research Experience for Medical Students (CREMS) project: We were delighted to have Elliott Wong, a University of Toronto medical student, work with us this summer on a scoping review aiming to identify and synthesize patient engagement and iKT approaches, methods and strategies used in consensus-building initiatives in the healthcare context.

iKT involvement:

A subset of iKT panel members have expressed interest and are actively involved with this scoping review. Our goal is for affiliated knowledge users to move from consultants to co-creators.

Progress to date:

- Scoping review meeting (July 19, 2023): iKT panel members met to provide their perspectives and input on the study protocol and key terms for the literature search, and how they wish to be involved.
- Level 1 screening of 5115 articles now complete.

In progress and next steps:

- Study protocol submitted for publication to BMJ Open
- Level 2 full text review, data abstraction, data analysis, review write-up ongoing
